Dear Parent/Guardian:

It is time to register your child for Summer School, and there are a few important details pertaining to the program that we would like to bring to your attention. Any child who has **“Summer School Mandatory”** or **“Summer School Recommended”** on his or her final report card is expected to attend. Please speak with your child’s teacher about this important requirement.

We need your application for the program as soon as possible to give first preference to your child/dren. We have limited space available as the program is also made available to non-CHA students and we have in the past turned students away.

Contrary to common belief, Summer School is not only for students who are academically challenged. It is also for students who are doing well. Studies have shown that students who do not attend Summer School usually return to school at a lower level than they were in June. It is therefore important that you include Summer School in your summer plans for your children. This includes Pre-kindergarten through grade 12.

Summer School/Day Camp starts on July 6 and ends on August 1, 2010 from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. The registration fee is \$25 per child and the tuition cost is \$840 per child. Please contact the school office for further information or the website www.chcinc.net.

This year we will be focusing on 3 components:

- English Language Arts – Reading, Writing (expository and narrative), Book Reports, Fundamentals of English Grammar; English for High School credit
- Mathematics – Elementary; High School math for High School credit, including preparation for the Regents Examination
- Specialized tutoring for students preparing for other Regents examinations

Day Camp, which starts at 2:00 p.m. each day except on Fridays when it is held from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., will focus on your child’s spiritual, social and physical development. We encourage you to send your child to experience the richness of this program.
